Hornline and Percussion Uniform Contract & Order Form

Due Monday August 5th, 2024 (first day of Band Camp)

Uniform guidelines:

All students are responsible for the proper care of their uniform. While in uniform, students are not allowed to:

- Eat or drink anything besides water.
- Wear jewelry or makeup of any kind, including foundation, cover up, lotion, mascara, eye liner, or lip balm
- Sit or lay down on the ground.
- Students are expected to wear proper attire under their uniform to facilitate changing after performances. (shorts, tank top, under armor, etc.)
- Students are expected to behave appropriately both in and out of uniform while at competitions.

Students are expected to properly fold and hang their uniform after every performance. If a student is observed not obeying the uniform guidelines, they will be subject to uniform inspection and may be responsible for dry cleaning fees if necessary. If a student does not properly maintain their uniform and the uniform is permanently damaged beyond repair, the student/parent or legal guardian will be responsible for the cost of replacing the complete uniform. Student grades and report cards will be withheld until restitution is made.



If your uniform is damaged due to a violation of the guidelines above you will be responsible for the following fees:

Uniform dry cleaning fee 15.00 and/or Uniform replacement fee is 360.00

Color Guard Uniform/Flag Contract & Order Form

Custom Uniform and Flag guidelines:

All students are responsible for the proper care of their uniform and flags. While in uniform, students are not allowed to:

- Eat or drink anything besides water.
- Wear jewelry of any kind.
- Sit or lay down on the ground.
- Students are expected to wear proper attire under their uniform to facilitate changing after performances. (shorts, tank top, under armor, etc.)
- Students are expected to behave appropriately both in and out of uniform while at competitions.
- Students who quit after uniforms and flags have been ordered will be responsible for the full cost of the uniform and flags. Participation in extracurricular activities such as prom, homecoming, etc will be withheld until restitution is made.

If a student does not properly maintain their uniform, or flags/equipment and is permanently damaged beyond repair, the student/parent or legal guardian will be responsible for the cost of replacing the complete uniform and/or flags.

If your uniform is damaged due to a violation of the guidelines above you will be responsible for the following fees:
